## assessment

We conduct basic skills testing for reading and math skills as well as aptitude and interest testing to guide you on your career path.

## self-assessment workshop

This workshop further guides you in the career decision making process by providing labor market information and remedial and vocational training information.

## job placement

We help you get back on your feet after a layoff in record time, with state of the art job search and placement techniques that really work!

## on-the-job training

Employers who provide training are reimbursed for training hours worked, and we assist them in developing a customized training program for you. You earn an appropriate wage while you are learning, and have the opportunity to learn a new career. Assistance is also available for special tools, equipment, or uniforms required for on-the-job training.

Other services available include childcare, interview clothing, out-of-area interview expenses, and credit counseling (provided through one of our partners, Consumer Credit Counseling).
