Adult Services

Adult Protective Services is intended to prevent or remedy abuse, neglect or exploitation of vulnerable persons eighteen years of age or older. The goal is to protect the well being, as well as the basic human rights and integrity, of the adult who is at risk. Services are available without regard to income. Twenty-four hour access to emergency APS is available through the Mendocino County Crisis Line.

Family and Children Services

The Child Welfare Services program provides risk assessment, in-person response, investigation, preventative services and placement services. A social worker is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide appropriate response to all reports of child abuse or neglect. Services and case planning are provided to work towards reunification of the family, maintaining at-risk children safely at home or permanency planning for children whom the court determines cannot safely remain with their families of origin.

We provide employment services to recipients of CalWORKs with the goal of obtaining self-sufficiency. We offer job skills workshops, work experience positions, vocational training and education, basic skills and GED preparation, and substance abuse, mental health, and domestic violence services.

Probation officers supervise juveniles placed on probation by the courts, monitoring and reporting their behavior to the Superior Court.
